

CAPTAIN'S CUP 2022

Rules and Regulations

RULES OF PLAY

The competition shall be played over 18 holes in accordance with the Rules of Golf currently adopted by the Royal and Ancient ("R&A") Golf Club of St. Andrews and the United States Golf Association ("USGA") and the Local Rules of NSRCC.

All complaints, protests and disputes shall be referred immediately to the Tournament Director, whose decision shall be final.

FORMAT OF PLAY

The Format Of Play will be **Double Peoria (Stableford)** played over 18 holes. The winner of the competition shall be the player who returns with the highest Stableford points. In the event of a tie, NSRCC's count-back system shall be used to determine the winner.

DIVISION

There shall be one (1) Open division for all participants.

Men Division - Handicap Index 0 - 24.4

Ladies Division - Handicap Index 0 - 36.4

DATE AND TIME

The competition shall be played at NSRCC Kranji on **Saturday, 3 September 2022**.

Morning session time sheet starts from 0708hrs to 0750hrs.

Shotgun start at 1315hrs (afternoon session) or at such time as the Committee may decide. All competitors must report to the Registration desk at least 15 minutes before their tee-off time. Any competitor who is late shall be subject to the appropriate penalty under the Rules. Competitors shall tee-off in the order of the draw.

No substitution or mutual interchange of tee-off times shall be permitted

ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to members and guests with handicaps maintained by

NSRCC or clubs associated with Singapore Golf Association (SGA) and who are amateurs in accordance with the R&A's and USGA's Rules of Amateur Status and who have a current handicap index of 24.4 or less for men and 36.4 or less for ladies. **Members with handicaps maintained by Malaysian, Indonesian and other foreign golf clubs are not eligible to participate in this competition.**

All competitors shall play off their handicaps as of event closing date. If a player gets his handicap revised before the closing date of the tournament, he or she should play off the revised handicap. Players who belong to more than one golf club must play off their lowest handicap held.

The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry without assigning any reason for such rejection.

ENTRY

Each member can sign up to three (3) guests.

The entry fee per competitor is **\$128.00 (Members), \$201.00 (Basic Members) and \$250.00 (Sign-in Guests) before GST** and is inclusive of green/buggy fees, dinner and prizes.

CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES

Entries shall close at **12.00 Noon on Friday, 26 August 2022.**

NO-SHOW BY COMPETITOR

If the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is loss of the first hole in match play or two strokes at the first hole in stroke play. Otherwise, the penalty for breach of this Rule is disqualification.

Competitors will be barred from participating in club events for the **next two (2) months**. Entrance fees paid will be **forfeited** and will be subjected to an additional surcharge equivalent to event green fees.

CANCELLATION BY COMPETITORS

For any cancellation request received **within three (3) days of event** which is on **31 August 2022**, competitors WILL have their green fees forfeited and also subjected to an additional surcharge equivalent to the event entrance fees. Competitors' name will be removed from tee-off time sheet. Competitors will be **barred** from participating in club events for **next two (2) months**. Competitors DO NOT have to pay for the event's entrance fees if cancellation request is received at least **three (3) days prior to event**.

CANCELLATION BY CLUB

In the event of a cancellation by the Club, Competitors **DO NOT** have to pay for the event's entrance fees for any cancellation or postponement decisions made by the Club due to incomplete/insufficient entries, or competition. Competitors affected will be allowed to maintain their tee time slot for social play.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event of inclement weather resulting in the inability of the field to complete play, the competition will be deemed as valid if two-thirds of the field have completed and the results of the competition shall be based on the scores returned. The Committee reserves the right to postpone or cancel the tournament as and when necessary in view of the situation.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE

The use of devices that measure only distance is permitted. A player is not permitted to carry or use devices that measure other conditions which might affect the play of the game.

SLOW PLAY

The attention of all competitors is drawn to Rule 5-6 regarding undue delay. The Committee will not hesitate to impose penalties under this rule.

Prizes will be awarded to the following:

3. Lucky Draw Prizes

DINNER AND PRIZE PRESENTATION

Dinner and prize presentation shall be held at The Sanctuary Room @ NSRCC Kranji on Saturday, 3rd September 2022 at a time to be advised. The dress code is smart casual.

All prizes must be collected personally. Prizes not collected after 2 December 2022 will be forfeited.
